Energy Affordability Program

The Energy Affordability Program (EAP) provides monthly bill discounts on gas delivery charges ranging from \$3-\$23.36. Discounts are subject to change.

Households who receive HEAP or another form of financial assistance from certain government or tribal programs may be eligible. Find the list of qualifying programs on the reverse side.

Accounts that are eligible for EAP will also be enrolled in a Budget Plan to help make winter bills more affordable.
